(sometimes there will be two volunteers sometimes one because game times on each field often differ.)

***Forester Ranch** – Each **VISITOR** team **MUST** provide **ONE** volunteer to work the snack shack.

AAA Team Moms - Your games will now be played at either Vista Bahia or Little San G! Yeah, we have a new Snack Shack. Please note:

***San G Snack Shack** - Each **VISITOR** team **MUST** provide **ONE** volunteer to work the snack

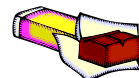
***Vista Bahia** - Each **VISITOR** team must assign **TWO** people to work the snack shack.

Majors Team Moms – MOST of you games will be at Vista Bahia. Some may be at San G. Those games played at Vista Bahia will be required to provide **TWO** volunteers to work the snack bar! For the games played at San G **ONLY ONE** volunteer is needed.

Snack bar volunteers are essential to our program. This is a huge revenue source for SCLL! It is fun for the players and it should be fun for the volunteers as well!

SAFETY FIRST

As Team Mom you are the "Safety Officer" for your team. We know you will not be hanging out at practices, but you will be at most every game. **(The Manager is responsible for filling out injury reports that occur during practices.)** If ANY player gets hurt in ANY way during a game it is your responsibility, NOT THE MANAGER, to fill out and turn in a Safety Report to our Safety Officer, Jon Brannon. You will be given a "Report" sheet to make copies of and keep on your person/car at every game. In addition, the manager and the snack bars will have copies.

As Team Mom and Safety Officer if you see any of the following, as well as other potential dangerous acts, it is your responsibility to make sure the coach is aware.

- Player should NOT handle bats in dugouts
- NO gum or food (seeds ok) in dug out
- Player may NOT wear ANY kind of jewelry
- Player needs to observe the "NO on-deck" rule.
- Helmets should be inspected for cracks
- NO SWINGING from Dug Out Roof!
